The film, *The World Within*, (1990/2008) examines some of the seminal teachings of Carl Jung. Early last century, Jung articulated the theory of the collective unconscious, which he believed is just as great an influence on a person as is his/her conscious mind. He thought it of paramount importance to make contact with the unconscious by examining the content of dreams, fantasies and artistic expression. The film gives a glimpse inside Jung's famous *Red Book*, a diary that chronicles his own journey into the unconscious. There is also archival film footage of Jung speaking about his work, and the responsibility of learning about the unconscious.
